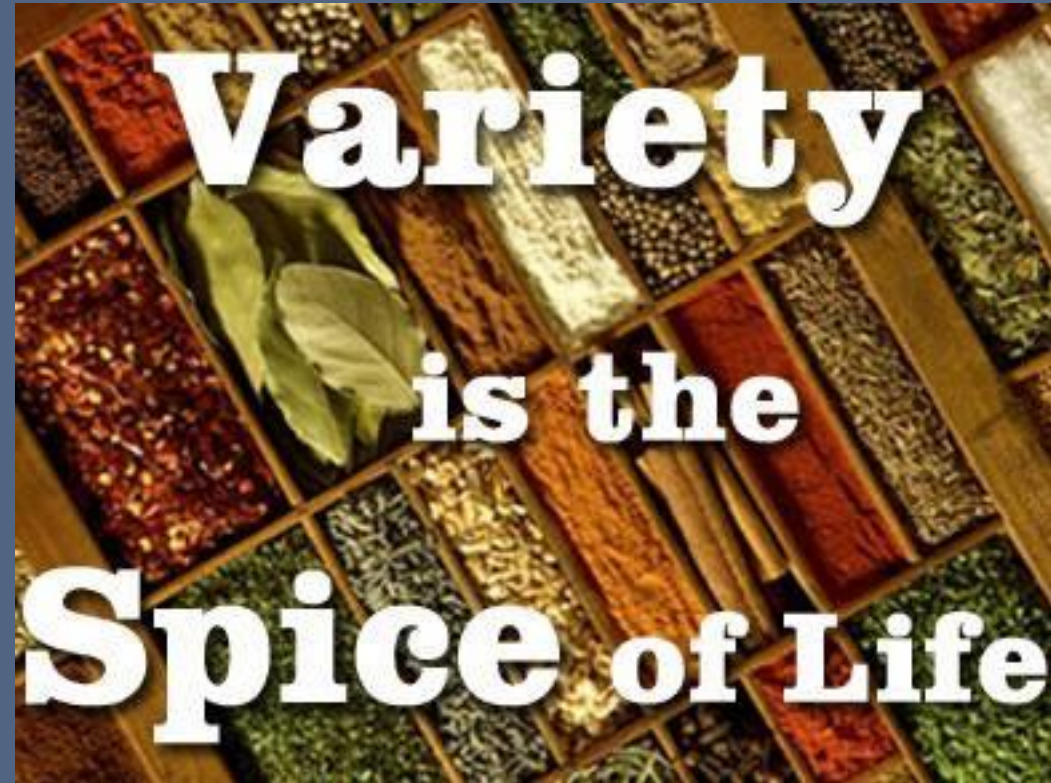

Each person is distinctive from another



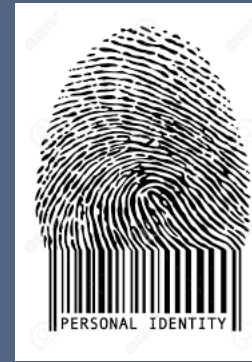
These differences and distinctions...

... Each person is different, and that is a good thing

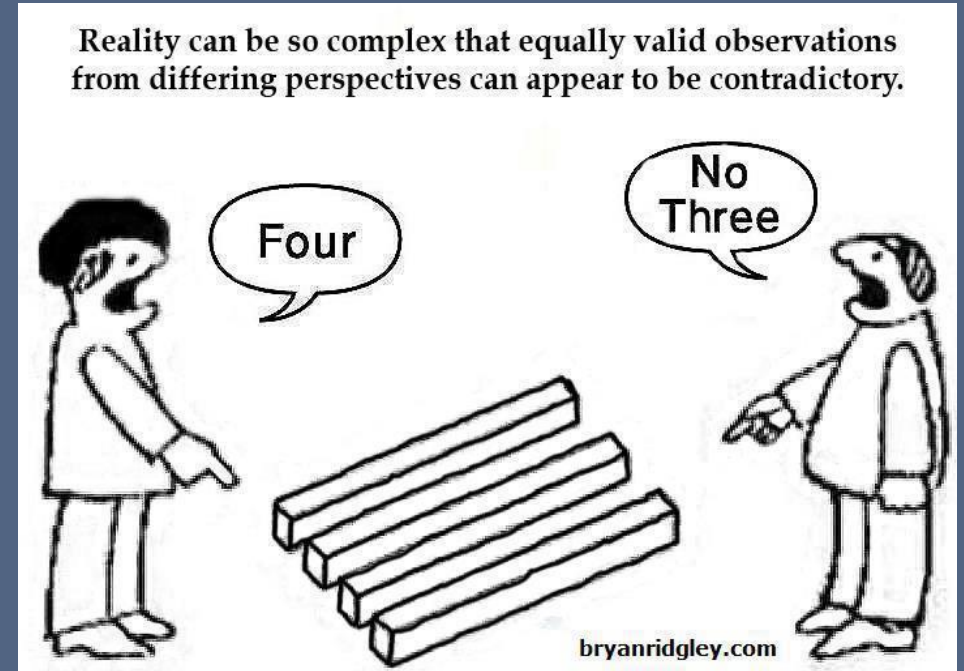
Activity: “Thumbbody”
